
We’ve said for many years, “We’re all in this together.” This is a testament to our dedication to serving students and providing them with the funding and services they need.

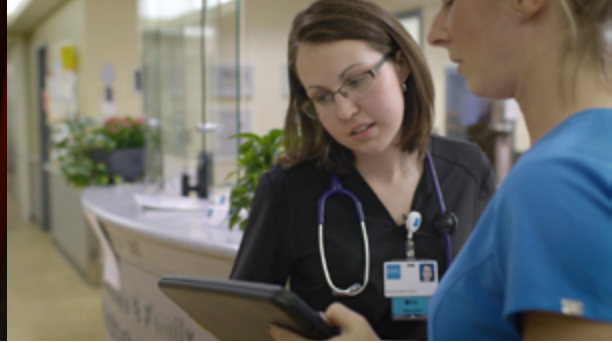

More than 6,700 professionals have graduated into front line careers. ## Scholarships

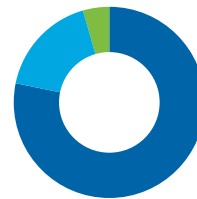
