Accelerated Bachelor's of Science in Nursing ABSN Program

Application Deadline was extended to April 26, 2024.



This is a full-time fast paced program that requires you to complete between 14 to 16 credits each semester. Consider adjusting your working hours to commit time to your success. Classes may be held any day between Monday and Saturday, day or evening. Clinical days may be any day of the week [Sunday to Saturday] on the day or evening shift.

HOW TO APPLY

- **If you are a New Student to Goodwin University:** Meet with your admissions representative to confirm your eligibility, then the admissions representative will submit your completed application to the nursing department by emailing jlassen@goodwin.edu
- **If you are a Current Student:** Meet with your academic advisor to confirm your eligibility, submit your completed application to the nursing department in person or by email jlassen@goodwin.edu
- **ALL students:**
 - Must have completed at least a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college or university. Official transcripts indicating a conferral degree and date must be submitted to Goodwin University admission office by the applicants before the deadline to be considered.
 - You must earn a minimum GPA of 3.0 in the most recent course work (college). GPA is based on the most recently attained collegiate degree or at least 12 completed credits at Goodwin University.
 - You must complete all six (6) pre-requisites by the end of the Fall 2023 semester. Updated official transcripts must be submitted to Goodwin University before the application deadline.
 - Students have a maximum of 4 attempts to apply to the ABSN program.

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TEAS EXAM INFORMATION

HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR TEAS SCORE

Submitting TEAS Scores to Goodwin University:

All applicants must transfer their TEAS score by **April 26, 2024**. When registering for your test, you may be prompted to select an institution to send your score to, please select **"Goodwin U BSN."** To have your score transferred automatically, **you must purchase ATI Credit for \$27 PRIOR to your scheduled exam.**

However, you may also submit a score manually after your exam by going to the ATI Online store, purchasing the \$27 ATI Credit, and selecting **"Goodwin U BSN"** as the recipient. If you miss the deadline to apply, you are not considered an applicant and any TEAS score submitted will not count.

To confirm that your score has been transferred, please contact ATI at 800-667-7531. **Students may only test ONCE PER APPLICATION CYCLE.** If multiple scores are submitted in the same cycle, we will use the first score submitted even if subsequent scores are higher. However, if you have scores submitted from previous application cycles, the highest score will always be used. Please make the nursing department aware of any name changes/differences. We locate scores by last name, if your full name on this application is different from the name used to register for ATI, we will not be able to find your scores!

HOW TO REGISTER FOR TEAS TESTING

- Testing for Goodwin University applicants is reserved during the sessions listed below and can accommodate up to 50 testers and is done remotely ONLY.
- For 1st time TEAS takers: you can register and take the testing during the reserved dates:
 - * 3/19/24 @ 8:00 am * 3/22/24 @ 8:00 am
 - * 4/16/24 @ 8:00 am * 4/19/24 @ 8:00 am
 - * 4/20/24 @ 9:00 am * 4/25/24 @ 12:00 pm
- For students who have previously taken the TEAS exam: you can submit the score that you already have OR you can retake the test during the provided dates.

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TEAS EXAM—ATI TESTING FAQ

What if I forget my Username/Password?

Contact ATI Customer Service, DO NOT CREATE NEW. Customer Service can be reached at 800.667.7531.

I am not currently enrolled in a school and the website asks for an institution, what should I put?

Select the school you will be testing with or select another as your institution. You can edit at any point once you create your account (edit profile in top right corner of page).

How do I locate my test scores?

Log into your ATI account, under the main menu select My Results, click on EXAM and scores will populate.

What do my scores mean?

You will need to contact your institution; ATI's policy is not to discuss scores with students.

Where can I go to purchase the TEAS Study Manual and/or Online Practice Exam?

You can purchase TEAS Study materials on the [ATI website](#) in our online store. Simply select shop online, TEAS Products, then select which option fits your needs.

How can I send a copy of my TEAS score/TEAS transcript to another school?

Go to ATI's online store and select the [TEAS Transcript](#) fee will apply. Transcripts are sent immediately by email.

What is the difference between TEAS V and ATI TEAS?

The ATI TEAS will be similar in difficulty level to the TEAS V. Content updates were made to align with current education standards deemed important for entry level health science applicants to possess. You can view an overview of the [ATI TEAS content here](#).

Can I use a calculator on the new ATI TEAS?

The ATI TEAS, being released August 31, 2016, will allow for the use of a four-function calculator. Please do not bring your own calculator as a calculator will be embedded within the online version of the exam.

How long is the exam?

- The exam is 209 minutes long
- There are 170 multiple choice questions (20 un-scored pre-test questions)
- A four-function calculator will be provided at the time of testing
