

CHILD STUDY CERTIFICATE

The **Child Study** certificate program is for working professionals and those new to the field of early childhood who need to meet federal and state educational requirements in a short amount of time. The practicum classes give students a unique opportunity to work directly with young children under the guidance of their professor. The two three-credit courses give the student an introductory foundation to early childhood education and equip students with knowledge in child development, educational theory, curriculum planning, state and federal guidelines, and involvement of families in an early learning setting. Additionally, this program meets all the requirements to allow graduates to apply to the Council For Professional Recognition for the Child Development Associate (CDA). The program comprises 18 credits and can be completed in two semesters. Time to completion and cost will vary with the number of credits for which a student enrolls each semester.
