### Graduation Rate and Transfer-Out Rate

<sup>1</sup> In 2014 Goodwin College enacted the Progressive Milestone Policy – this policy states “First-time students begin their college career by enrolling in an Associate’s Degree program. They became eligible for credential (e.g. collegiate certificate) after required coursework is completed. They may move into a Baccalaureate Degree program appropriate to their educational goals after they have successfully completed a full semester of collegiate coursework.” Because of this policy, there are very few FTFT bachelors students (231 in the graduation rate listed at the bottom of this page), and moving forward there will be none.
