Goodwin College's annual pass rate for the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX) is 85.15% (State Board of Examiners for Nursing, May 1, 2015 – April 30, 2016). Program completion rate for the Nursing program is 94% (three most recent cohorts, September 2015 to April 2016). Goodwin's job placement rate in Nursing is assessed annually in November, with data as reported by students; current rate for November 2014 to November 2015 is 68%.
