All Applicants must: 1. Be a high school graduate or 2. Earn a General Education Development (GED)	A complete application consists of: 1. An application form that is fully completed. 2. TEAS test score of 48% or greater. 3. Proof of high school or GED. After Acceptance: The LPN department will collect the following materials from students prior to beginning the program: <ul style="list-style-type: none">An essay detailing your interest in the field of nursing (300 words or less).A letter from a family member, friend, counselor, previous teacher, employer etc. speaking to your commitment to the program.Virtual meeting with LPN facultyPlease be aware that should you be admitted into the LPN program, accepted students must satisfy additional requirements prior to beginning their studies

HOW TO APPLY

- New Student to Goodwin University:** Meet with your admissions officer who will confirm your eligibility and submit your completed application to the nursing department.
- Current Goodwin Student:** Meet with your academic advisor to confirm your eligibility, submit your completed application to lpnnursing@goodwin.edu

ATI TEAS TEST INFORMATION

HOW TO REGISTER FOR TEAS TESTING

- First-Time TEAS test takers:**
- Register and take the exam during the reserved dates: <https://atitesting.com/teas/register/teas-online-at-institution>
 - When you get to the site, select **Register**.
 - On the next screen, select **Institution Remote Proctoring-Nursing** from the dropdown menu.
 - More fields should then appear that allow you to choose the state and institution.
 - Select CT and ACES/Professional Development and School Improvement.
 - Scroll to see list of the following available testing dates: **TBD**
 - A maximum of 50 testers can be accommodated on each date; testing is done **only** remotely.
- Previous TEAS Test Takers:** Transfer your score to **Goodwin U LPN** OR retake the test on the dates provided.

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HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR TEAS SCORE

All applicants must transfer their TEAS score by **July 26, 2024**. When registering for your test, you may be prompted to select an institution to send your score to, please select **“Goodwin U LPN.”**

To have your score transferred automatically, you must purchase ATI Credit for \$27 PRIOR to your scheduled exam. However, you may also submit a score manually after your exam by going to the ATI Online store, purchasing the \$27 ATI Credit, and selecting “Goodwin U LPN” as the recipient.

If you miss the deadline to apply, you are not considered an applicant and any TEAS score submitted will not count. **To confirm that your score has been transferred, please contact ATI at 800-667-7531.**

Students may only take the test **ONCE PER APPLICATION CYCLE**. If multiple scores are submitted in the same cycle, we will use the first score submitted even if subsequent scores are higher. However, if you have scores submitted from previous application cycles, the highest score will always be used.

Please make the nursing department aware of any name changes/differences. We locate scores by last name, if your full name on this application is different from the name used to register for ATI, we will not be able to find your scores!

ATI TEAS EXAM—FAQ

What if I forget my Username/Password?

Contact ATI Customer Service, DO NOT CREATE NEW. Customer Service can be reached on 800.667.7531.

I am not currently enrolled in a school and the website asks for an institution, what should I put?

Select the school you will be testing with or select another as your institution. You can edit at any point once you create your account (edit profile in top right corner of page).

How do I locate my test scores?

Log into your ATI account, under the main menu select My Results, click on EXAM and scores will populate.

What do my scores mean?

You will need to contact your institution; ATI's policy is not to discuss scores with students.

Where can I go to purchase the TEAS Study Manual and/or Online Practice Exam?

You can purchase TEAS Study materials on the [ATI website](#) in our online store. Simply select shop online, TEAS Products, then select which option fits your needs.

How can I send a copy of my TEAS score/TEAS transcript to another school?

Go to ATI's online store and select the [TEAS Transcript](#) fee will apply. Transcripts are sent immediately by email.

What is the difference between TEAS V and ATI TEAS?

The ATI TEAS will be similar in difficulty level to the TEAS V. Content updates were made to align with current education standards deemed important for entry level health science applicants to possess. You can view an overview of the [ATI TEAS content here](#).

Can I use a calculator on the new ATI TEAS?

The ATI TEAS, being released August 31, 2016, will allow for the use of a four-function calculator. Please do not bring your own calculator as a calculator will be embedded within the online version of the exam.

How long is the exam?

- The exam is 209 minutes long
- There are 170 multiple choice questions (20 un-scored pre-test questions)
- A four-function calculator will be provided at the time of testing
