- 1. You must apply BEFORE registering for the TEAS exam or submitting a score.
 - FIRST TIME and RETURNING applicants must fill out and submit a new application via email to adnnursing@goodwin.edu.
 - Due to the change in eligibility requirements, all applicants must submit a new application.
 REACTIVATION OF A PREVIOUS APPLICATION IS NOT ALLOWED.
 - This application is fillable. You can edit it in your web browser or PDF editor, save it and then submit as one PDF document.

- All applicants: You will be required to complete the eligibility form on the following page.
- Eligibility Requirements:
 - Students must have a minimum GPA of 2.7 from Goodwin University. GPAs from other colleges and universities will not be applied to this application.
 - Prerequisite courses completed with a C+ or better:
 - Anatomy and Physiology 1
 - Anatomy and Physiology 2
 - Microbiology

Courses must be already transferred, completed or currently in progress at the time of submission.

Updated official transcripts must be submitted to Goodwin University before the application deadline. Please confirm with your advisor that your transcripts are current and uploaded into Ellucian Self Service. Students have a **maximum of 6 attempts** to apply to the ADN (Associate Degree in Nursing) program.

There is no minimum number of points required to apply for the nursing program. The Nursing Department cannot accept all those who apply, each semester there will be a cut off score that determines who will be accepted.

The cut off score varies each semester and is all dependent on our applicant pool.

The cut off score for the Fall 2024 application cycle was 15 points. All applicants who scored 15 or higher were admitted.

If you have not yet completed a TEAS exam or are retaking the TEAS, this chart will help you determine the minimum composite score needed to meet your desired number of points.

TEAS Exam Registration Instructions

- Registration dates for the TEAS exam are from July 6, 2024 September 4, 2024.
- You must submit an application **BEFORE** registering for the exam. If you miss the deadline to apply, you cannot register for the exam or submit a TEAS score.

- Each date can accommodate up to 50 test takers per session on the ATI website.
- To register for your TEAS test, go to www.atitesting.com/teas/register and click "Register Now."
- 2. Select "Remote Online." In the drop-down menu select "Institution Remote Proctor Nursing"
- 3. Then, select "CT" and "ACES/Professional Development and School Improvement"
- 4. Scroll to see a list of available dates and select one to continue registration.
- 5. After proceeding to checkout, you will then be prompted to either login to an existing ATI account or to create a new account.

Submitting TEAS Scores:

All applicants must transfer their TEAS score by September 4th, 2024. When registering for your test, you will be prompted to select an institution to send your score to, please select "Goodwin U ADN."

To have your score transfered automatically, you must purchase ATI Credit for \$27 PRIOR to your scheduled exam. However, you may also submit a score manually after your exam by going to the ATI Online store, purchasing the \$27 ATI Credit, and selecting "Goodwin U ADN" as the recipient.

If you miss the deadline to apply, you are not considered an applicant and any TEAS score submitted will not count. <u>To</u> confirm that your score has been transferred, please contact ATI at 800-667-7531.

Students may only test **ONCE PER APPLICATION CYCLE.** If multiple scores are submitted in the same cycle, we will use the first score submitted even if subsequent scores are higher. However, if you have scores submitted from previous application cycles, the highest score will always be used.

Please make the nursing department is aware of any changes to your name. We locate scores by last name, if your full name on this application is different from the name used to register for ATI, we will not be able to find your scores.

Decision letters will be mailed out the week of October 8th, 2024.

TEAS

Where can I go to purchase the TEAS Study Manual and/or Online Practice Exam?

You can purchase TEAS Study materials on our website at our online store. Simply select shop online, TEAS Products, then select which option fits your needs.

How can I send a copy of my TEAS score/TEAS transcript to another school?

Go to ATI's online store and select the <u>TEAS Transcript</u> fee, there is a \$27 charge. Transcripts are sent immediately by email.

What is the difference between TEAS V and ATI TEAS?

The ATI TEAS will be similar in difficulty level to the TEAS V. Content updates were made to align with current education standards deemed important for entry level health science applicants to possess. You can view an overview of the ATI TEAS content here.

Can I use a calculator on the new ATI TEAS?

The ATI TEAS, being released August 31, 2016, will allow for the use of a four function calculator. Please do not bring your own calculator as a calculator will be embedded within the online version of the exam.

How long is the exam?

- The exam is 209 minutes long
- There are 170 multiple choice questions (20 un-scored pre-test questions)
- A four function calculator will be provided at the time of testing
