

When you're managing sensitive medical and financial information, it's important to communicate with compassion.



The Medical Billing and Coding program has a hybrid capstone requirement.


During your final semester, you'll complete a hybrid capstone course, balancing your time between remote classes and in-person learning. Days and times for capstones vary by semester.




