1. You must apply **BEFORE** registering for the exam. If you miss the deadline to submit an application, you cannot register for the exam or submit a TEAS score.
 2. You will need an ATI account in order to register. If you need to make one, go to www.atitesting.com. On the home page, select "create an account" located under the log in section, and follow the steps.
 3. Once logged in to your ATI account, go to "online store" at the top of the page. At the online store, look to the left hand side under "Register for..." and click on TEAS.
 4. If prompted, fill in the blanks (TEAS for Nursing students, USA, Connecticut, Hamden). Otherwise continue.
 5. Next you will see the "browse sessions" page. **You can register for ONE (1) exam date and time only.**
 6. Click "Register" next to the exam you want to take. Exam sessions have limited space and are first come, first serve. You will be brought to the checkout screen and be prompted to pay. **Exam schedule will be available online on the registration page during the registration period. Test dates will be between March 2 and 7, 2019 AT THE Hamden location with day, night, and evening options.**

What if I forget my Username/Password?

How can I send a copy of my TEAS score/TEAS transcript to another school?

Go to ATI's online store and select the [TEAS Transcript](#) fee, there is a \$27 charge. Transcripts are sent immediately by email.

What is the difference between TEAS V and ATI TEAS?

Can I use a calculator on the new ATI TEAS?

The ATI TEAS, being released August 31, 2016, will allow for the use of a four function calculator. Please do not bring your own calculator as a calculator will be embedded within the online version of the exam.

How long is the exam?

- The exam is 209 minutes long
- There are 170 multiple choice questions (20 un-scored pre-test questions)
- A four function calculator will be provided at the time of testing
