Students must complete all Bachelor-level general graduation requirements as stated in the catalog. Additionally, it is required that students complete the Professional Studies Capstone (PRO 495).

Must be completed at Goodwin:

- A minimum of 30 credits or 25% of the graduation credits must be completed at Goodwin University.
- A minimum of 15 credits in the major core must be completed at Goodwin University.
- The last 12 credits must be completed at Goodwin University.
- 20 hours of documented community service and required submissions

Can be completed at Goodwin or transferred in:

- Military credit
- Professional Studies Capstone
- Get college credits for what you already know through Credit By Exam.
- A cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher and a cumulative GPA of 2.5 for the major
