Admission requirements

LPN Program

Application and admission requirements are as follows:

- Complete the ATI TEAS Exam with a minimum passing score of 48%.
- Send proof of high school diploma or GED.
- Write an essay detailing both your interest in the program and your professional goals (300 word maximum).
- Submit two letters of recommendation (from employers, teachers, counselors, or mentors).
- Successfully interview with LPN faculty.

Requirements for accepted students:

- Submit a non-refundable \$500 tuition deposit.
- Send proof of immunization records.
- Undergo a medical examination by your healthcare provider.


