TITLE:

Early College Programs – Academic Amnesty

INTRODUCTION STATEMENT:

Early College Programs (ECP) allows high school students the opportunity to take Goodwin courses. They are a distinct subset within the Goodwin student body and provided is a description of a transcript amnesty policy. The aim of this policy is to encourage students to undertake the challenge of college classes, but not to penalize them if they should struggle which could negatively impact their future academic pursuits.

POLICY STATEMENT:

Early College Program students with 12 or less credits can complete an Academic Amnesty Petition to have grades of a F, UG, or W expunged from their transcript (by being replaced with a W*).
